

## Louella King Memorial Scholarship Fund

The Louella King Memorial Scholarship fund was established in memory of Mrs. Louella King, a long time member of First Mount Olive Baptist Church in Leesburg, VA. As a dedicated member of First Mount Olive, Mrs. King unselfishly made numerous contributions to the church and others. She exemplified the steward servant in all of her work within the church and throughout the community.

The mission of the Scholarship Fund is to foster, encourage and promote the educational, personal, spiritual growth and development of students who are active members of First Mount Olive Baptist Church. It is our belief that as a church family, we have a moral and spiritual obligation to provide assistance to our children in helping them to attain their educational goals.

The scholarship fund assists students by awarding non-competitive scholarships to every graduating high school senior that applies and meets the following criteria:

- An active member of First Mount Olive Baptist Church one year prior to graduation;
- An active member must regularly attend church and participate in ministry work;
- A graduating high school senior of current year;
- Accepted as a full-time student at an accredited college, university or technical school

The scholarship award can be used to help defray the cost of tuition fees, books, and other educational costs for students who need help in paying for college expenses.

Awards will be presented during the month of July on an annual basis. The tentative date has been set for July 8, 2012 immediately following the morning service. The scholarship check will be paid directly to the educational institution.

Students receiving an award should be aware that educational institutions may reduce other financial aid by the amount of the scholarship award paid to the educational institution on the student's behalf.

If you meet the criteria for this scholarship award, you are encouraged to apply for the Louella King Memorial Scholarship Award.

“Service to the Lord” Award:

A student who has been an active member that graduates from high school, but will not be attending college may submit a written essay (100 words minimum) on the topic, How has having a personal relationship with Jesus Christ changed your life. The Service to the Lord Award is a monetary gift to the student for achievement of graduating from high school. Return completed essay by June 3, to:
